

## Accuplacer Fact Sheet

- The Accuplacer test is used by many colleges, including CNM, to place you in different levels of classes.
- There are 3 sections: Reading, Sentence Skills, and Math.
- To be placed in college-level classes which count toward a college major, or in some cases, to be accepted into certain departments/majors, you need to score at a certain level:
  - Reading: 80
  - Sentence Skills: 85
  - Math (Arithmetic and/or Elementary Algebra): score depends on the course you'd like to take – see Ms. Wright for details

- You can take one section of the test at time.
- Each section has 20 questions and is not timed.
- If you don't get the score you need, you can study and retake the test every 24 hours until you reach your goal, so there's NO STRESS!
- You can pick up a study guide from the Accuplacer Bulletin Board at the top of the stairs, or from Ms. Hutchinson.
